Directions to ETC

Directions from I-16: Take I-95 South. Exit on GA Hwy 204. Turn left onto GA Hwy 204 East. Follow GA Hwy 204 east for 7.9 miles (13.4 km). Turn Right on Science Drive/Armstrong Atlantic State University campus. Turn left on Burnett Boulevard and then right onto Arts Drive. Everyone is required to stop at the Campus Police Station and get a parking pass in order to park in the student spaces on campus. Here is link to a map of the campus:

The police station is located in building number 16 on the map. From the police station, get back on Arts Drive and turn left onto Burnett Boulevard. Continue onto University Drive. Go all the way until the road ends and the ETC will be on your left. The Educational Technology Center is located in University Hall, Room 128.

Park in one of the student parking lots.

Directions from downtown Savannah: Head South on Abercorn Street. Remain on Abercorn (Approximately 12-14 miles if coming from Bay Street area). Proceed to intersection of Science Drive and Abercorn. Take left at Science Drive onto Armstrong campus. Turn left on Burnett Boulevard and then right onto Arts Drive. Everyone is required to stop at the Campus Police Station and get a parking pass in order to park in the student spaces on campus.
